Homeschool Experience at QCS

Quakertown Christian School desires to partner with, support and encourage homeschool families in the community. QCS offers multiple opportunities to enhance your family's homeschool program. Homeschool students may participate in education and/or enrichment classes. Students in 5th-12th grade are invited to join our athletic teams.

Homeschool Program Options

1. **Regularly Scheduled Classes** - Homeschool students may participate in the following:
 - Partial Credit courses - including music, art, physical education, Spanish, and robotics.
 - Music Program – including group lessons, ensemble, and band (during the school day).
 - Full Credit Academic Courses* (Gr. K-8) - English/Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, Bible and Math
 - Full Credit High School Academic Courses* (Gr. 9-10)- English, Science, Math, Social Studies and Bible
2. **After School Sports** (Gr. 5-12) - Girls' Volleyball, Girls' and Boys' Basketball, Track/Field and Boys' Soccer
3. **Chapels, Special Assemblies, Events, and Library facilities** – Registered homeschoolers are welcome to attend Chapels, Special Assemblies and Events (including Race for Education and Field Day) when enrolled in a regularly scheduled class at QCS. Library facilities may be used on a regular basis under the Librarian's supervision when a class is not in session. Books and videos may be borrowed by registered homeschoolers.
4. **Drama Production** - Spring drama performance. Practices are held after school hours, November through April in preparation for spring performance.
5. **Drama Club** – Weekly during school hours, 45 minute club that performs during chapel
6. **Robotics Club** – The middle school and high school robotics each meet for 2 periods a week and competitions are on weekends. We participate in the Vex Robotics competitions. Students learn to build, program, and drive robots.

*Registration deadline for Full Credit Courses is August 15.

Admissions Procedures

All homeschool families desiring participation in the QCS Homeschool Program must complete the following:

- Homeschool Program Application for Admission along with \$75 Application fee
**This is a yearly application fee per family
- Students enrolling in academic courses will attend an admissions interview and records review with the Admissions Director and School Administrator
- Be familiar with and adhere to all QCS rules and guidelines as stated in the QCS Student Handbook while participating in any school activity and on school property.
- Pay all tuition costs or fees prior to first class.

Homeschool Program Grade Reporting

Homeschool students (K-5th) enrolled in enrichment classes are provided with a letter of completion and grade. Students (6th-12th) enrolled in academic courses are provided with a student web login to review grades throughout the course and a final grade report at course completion.

Homeschool Program Fees

Admissions Fee

\$75 per family per year

Grades K-8

- Partial Credit Courses (1X per week) \$350 per year
- Core Academic Courses (5X per week) \$475 per year
- Textbook Rental (required for academic courses) \$40 per year

Grades 9-12

- Partial Credit Courses (2X per week) \$500 per year
- Full Credit Courses (4-5X per week) \$1,000 per year

Music Program (Grades K-12)

- Ensembles/Group Lessons \$350 per year
- Instrument Rental **

Sports Program (Grades 5-12)

- Middle School Sports \$100 per sport
- High School Sports \$150 per sport
