

Homeschool Enrichment Program

Homeschool Program Partnership

Quakertown Christian School desires to partner with, support, and encourage homeschool families in the community. QCS offers multiple opportunities to enhance your family's homeschool program. Homeschool students may participate in education and/or enrichment classes. Students in 5th-12th Grade are invited to join our athletic teams.

Homeschool Program Options

- 1. **Instructional Materials** QCS will make instructional material available as school supplies permit. Homeschooling families can choose to rent textbooks from QCS at a cost of \$40 per year. Textbook rental is required for all core academic courses.
- 2. **Regularly Scheduled Classes** Homeschooled students may participate in the following classes as there is room in the classroom and for those registered in the program:
 - <u>Partial Credit courses</u> including music, art, physical education, STEAM and library instruction.
 - <u>Music Program</u> including group lessons, ensemble, and band which practice during the school day.
 - <u>Full Credit Middle School Academic Courses</u> (Gr. 6-8) English, Literature, Social Studies, Science, Bible, and Math.
 - Full Credit High School Academic Courses (Gr. 9-10) English, Science, Math, and Bible.
- 3. **After School Sports** Girls' Volleyball, Girls' and Boys' Basketball, Track/Field and Boys' Soccer will be offered for students in Grades 5 12. Per A.C.C.A.C. League rules, homeschooler participation may be limited.
- 4. Chapels, Special Assemblies, and Events Homeschoolers are welcome to attend Chapels, Special Assemblies and Events (including Race for Education and Field Day) if enrolled for a regularly scheduled class at QCS.
- 5. **Library Use** The QCS Library facilities may be used on a regular basis under the Librarian's supervision when a class is not in session. Books and videos may be borrowed.
- 6. **Drama Chapel Drama Club:** Meets once per week during the school day for 45 minutes. Auditions are not required for participation in Chapel Drama Club.

After School Drama: Meets after school seasonally in preparation for a Fall and Spring drama performance. Students who participate in the After School Drama club must successfully audition to participate.

Scheduling and Admissions Procedures

All homeschooled families wishing to participate in the homeschool program need to complete the following steps to register and enroll.

- Complete the Homeschool Program Application for Admission
- Pay the \$75 Homeschool Program Registration Fee
- Students enrolling in academic courses will be required to attend an admissions interview and records review with the Admissions Director and School Administrator.

Responsibilities of the Homeschool Family

- 1. Complete the QCS Home School Student Application
- 2. Be familiar with and adhere to QCS policies and procedures as stated in the parent handbook while participating in a school program or activity.
- 3. Pay all tuition costs prior to the first class.
- 4. Support QCS in your prayers and with a positive spirit.
- 5. Attend QCS events and activities in which your child participates.

Homeschool Program Grade Reporting

Homeschool students in grades K-5 who are registered for enrichment classes will be provided with a letter stating the student's participation and final grade in the enrichment course. Students who are enrolled in academic courses in grades 6-10 will be given a student web login to review grades throughout the course; a final grade report will be issued at the end of the year.
